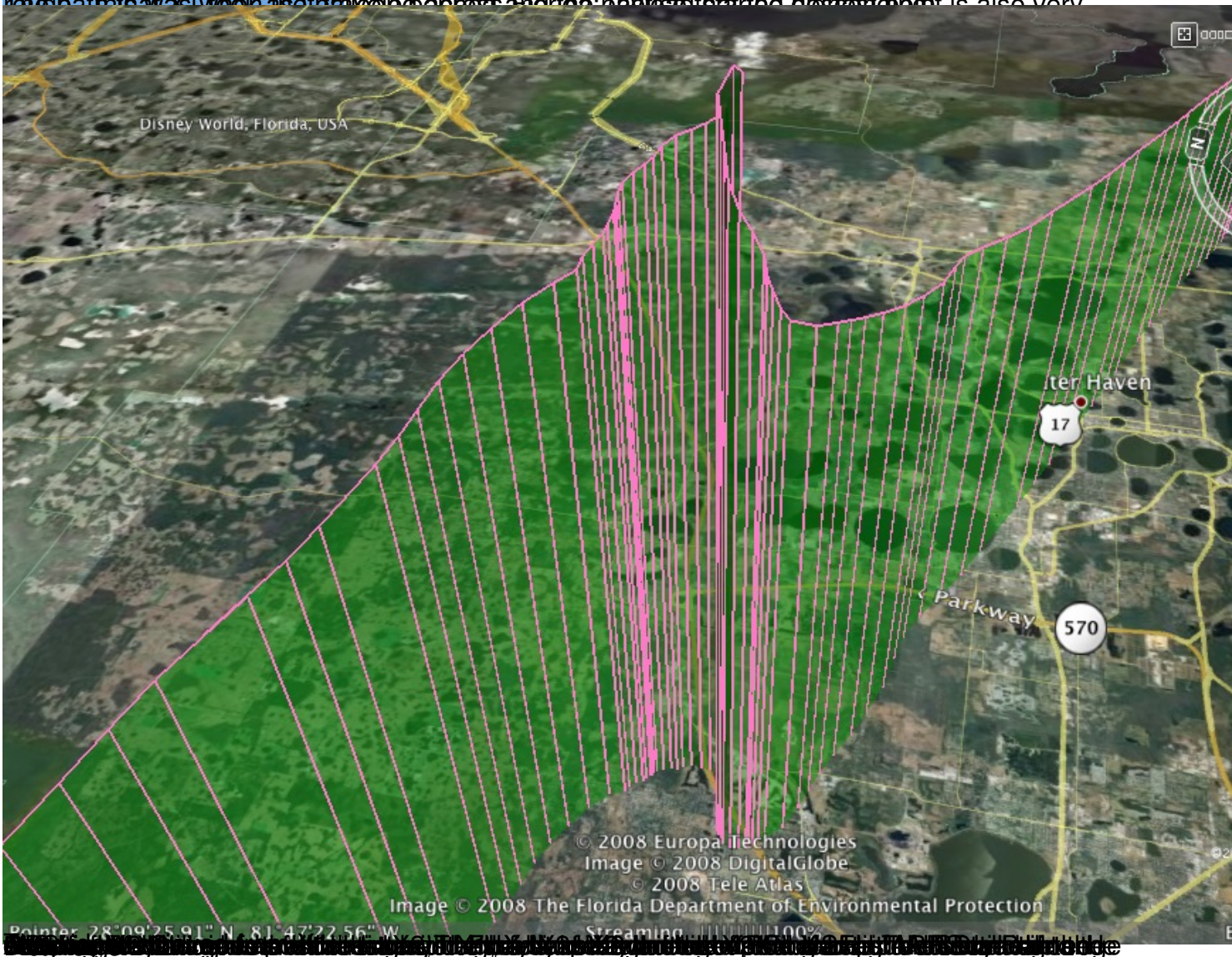

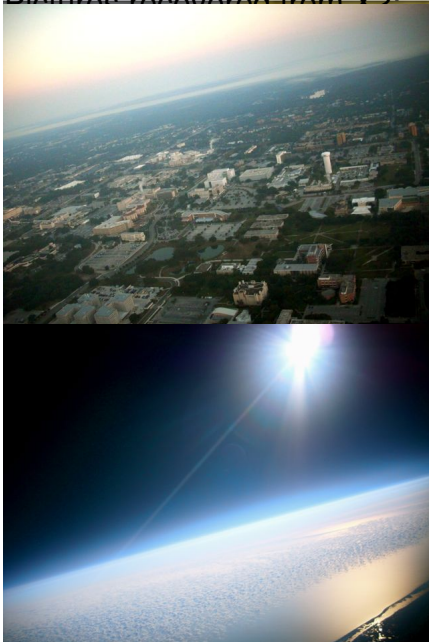
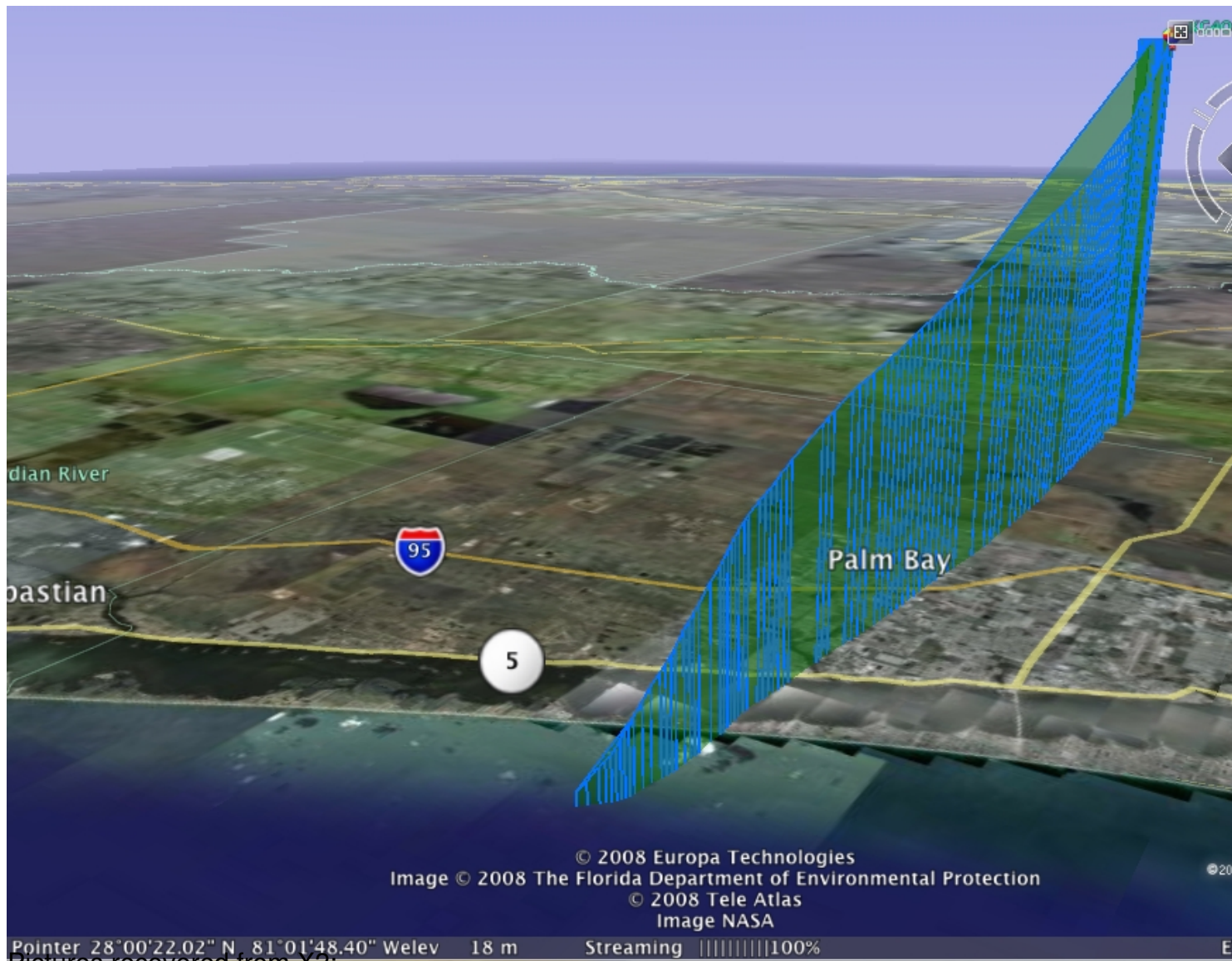
The path that X2 took across Florida and into the Atlantic:
